Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant status of Class-III employee to the petitioner who is working on the post of Lab Attendant being matriculate as the post has been re-designated as Class-III post in pursuance to Annexure P-1.

2. Petition was admitted for hearing in the year 2001.

3. On an earlier hearing held on 06.09.2022, it was observed that counsel for the petitioner, who earlier filed the petition had expired, therefore, registry was directed to issue notice to the petitioner, still none appears today.

In the premise, no useful purpose would be served by issuing fresh notice to the petitioner as the same too would be an exercise in futility.

Even the particulars of addresses of the petitioner are also perhaps not complete, as is borne out from the memo of parties.

4. It seems that by sheer effluxion of time and pendency of the writ petition for more than 21 years before this Court, either it has been rendered infructuous or even otherwise the petitioner seems to have lost interest in pursuing the same.

5. Be that as it may, writ petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate application in case any cause of action still survives.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
