AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition is filed seeking partial quashing of FIR No. 0009 dated 1.1.2021 registered at under Sections 420/120 B IPC and Section 24 of Immigration Act at P.S. Division-5, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of the compromise.

There are seven accused in the FIR, the matter was compromised with two accused. The parties got their statement recorded in pursuance to the order of this Court. Learned counsel for the respondent No.2 on instructions submits that petitioners are not adhering to the compromise.

It would not be appropriate for this Court at this stage to comment upon as to whether it is a case of partial quashing of FIR or not.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner in view of the statement

made by learned counsel for the private respondent seeks permission to withdraw this petition with liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law and for recovery of the amount paid to the private respondent in pursuance to the compromise.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
