Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0014 dated 26.01.2022 for offences punishable under Sections 420, 406 and 448 IPC registered at Police Station Passiana, Tehsil & District Patiala.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 08.03.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 08.03.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 08.03.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the

investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
