Challenge is to the order dated 06.06.2014 passed by the learned trial Court, vide which the petitioner was declared as a proclaimed offender in case bearing FIR No. 126 dated 24.11.2011, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC.

Vide order dated 23.03.2017, notice of motion was issued with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court. On 10.10.2020, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner and it was submitted by the learned State counsel that the petitioner has not surrendered before the learned trial Court in compliance of the order dated 23.03.2017, therefore, in the interest of justice, the case was adjourned for today.

Even today, nobody is representing the petitioner.

Learned State counsel on the instruction from ASI Harpal Singh, submits that till date the petitioner has not surrendered before the learned trial Court.

I have heard the learned State counsel and have also gone through the documents on record.

Since the petitioner has not surrendered before the learned trial Court, the conduct of the petitioner shows disrespect to the orders passed by this Court, therefore, no further indulgence of this Court is call for.
