Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.0242 dated 22.12.2020, registered for offences under Sections 120-B, 323, 324, 354, 354-A, 406, 452, 498-A and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Nigdhu Karnal, District Karnal, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 14.01.2021, Annexure P-3, arrived at between the parties.

Report has been received from the Trial Court pursuant to order dated 05.03.2021 passed by this Court and its relevant extract is as under:-

“Both the parties were asked as to whether the compromise has been arrived between them or not? Upon which, complainant-Seema stated that no compromise has not (sic) been arrived between her and accused/petitioners. Her statement to that effect has been recorded that her husband-Partish Kumar denied given the divorce to her, due to which, she wants to pursue the present case. She further stated that no compromise has been effected between her and accused/petitioners. As the complainant has suffered the statement regarding no compromise has been effected between her (sic them), so, no further statement of petitioners were recorded as they refused to suffer any statement regarding the same. As no compromise has been effected between the parties, the present report is hereby submitted.”

Reply by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Karnal-II has been filed on behalf of State-respondent No.1, which is taken on record.

In view of the above report, the petition cannot be entertained and is hereby dismissed.
