[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of orders (Annexure P-1 & P-2) dated 12.01.2021 in CWP No.12851 of 2020 and CWP No.4248 of 2020 respectively.

[2] Replies have been filed along with orders (Annexures R-1 & R-2) dated 29.12.2017 and 29.03.2022 respectively. The same are taken on record. Copies thereof have already been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in view of orders (Annexures R-1 & R-2), rejecting the claim of the petitioner, the petitioner does not press the instant petition while praying for grant of liberty to challenge orders (Annexures R-1 & R-2) by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[3] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner, as prayed for.
