The prayer made by the petitioner in the instant writ petition is for issuance of necessary directions to officials respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect his life and liberty, which is stated to be under imminent danger from respondents No.4 and 5 and to file status report in respect of complaint dated 26.01.2022 (Annexure P-1) moved by him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the daughter of petitioner was married to Balbit Singh, who was brother of respondent No.4. The couple was issueless and they both died in a road side accident. However, to usurp the compensation amount under the Motor Accident

Claims and other benefits, respondent No.4 forged the documents/ records and thereby shown his own daughter as the daughter of deceased Balbit Singh. According to learned counsel, despite submitting a complaint dated 26.01.2022(Annexure P-1), no action has been taken thereupon.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Hittan Nehra, Addl. Advocate General, who has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 on service of advance copy of petition, has accepted the notice. He submits that representation, Annexure P-1 will be looked into by respondent No.2.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation (Annexure P-1) and decide the same in accordance with law, preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copies of this order and representation (Annexure P-1)

Instant writ petition stands disposed of with abovesaid observations and directions.
