Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks quashing of a Calandara issued under Section 182 IPC arising out of FIR No.30 dated 29.03.2016 registered under Sections 34, 354 and 506 IPC at Women Police Station, Mewat.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that in the impugned proceedings, through the order of the Trial Court dated 19.03.2018, the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed offender and therefore, has disentitled himself to be heard on merits.

In view of the afore development, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the aforesaid order declaring him to be a proclaimed offender.
