Prayer in this 2nd petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.653 dated 20.12.2021 registered under Sections 21(b) of the NDPS Act (Section 27-A of the NDPS Act, added later) at Police Station City Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

The earlier one was dismissed as withdrawn on 14.01.2022, noticing the fact that some other case are pending against the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is involved in one more case under the NDPS Act i.e. in FIR No.374 dated 18.12.2021 registered under Section 22(b) of the NDPS Act, at Police Station City Ratia, District Fatehabad.

As per the allegations in the FIR, the police party apprehended Premjit wife of Anoop Singh on 20.12.2021 and recovered 10.35 gms. of Heroin in presence of a Gazetted Officer and thereafter, the petitioner was nominated as a Supplier of the drugs.

After hearing the counsel for the parties and finding that the petitioner is involved in one more FIR under the NDPS Act and considering his antecedents, I find no ground to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
