Through the present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus for release of his daughter-Shama Sota who is alleged to be missing since 25.02.2022.

At the outset, learned State counsel, who appears on advance notice, submits that in addition to the filing of the present petition the petitioner had also approached the police with regard to his missing daughter with a further allegation in the complaint that the petitioner's daughter may have been enticed away by respondent No.4. Acting on the petitioner's complaint, the police has lodged a FIR under Section 366 IPC and is investigating the same, in accordance with law.

The aforesaid statement made on behalf of the State satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner.

In the light of the above, at this stage, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition.
