The instant revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, seeking directions to the learned Court of Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Ganaur, to decide the application filed by the petitioner/plaintiff under Order 39, Rules 1 & 2 CPC (annexed as Annexure P-2), for injunction against the respondents/defendants, which is stated to be lying pending since 15.11.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the next date in the application filed by the petitioner/plaintiff under Order 39, Rules 1 & 2 CPC, is fixed for 21.04.2022. He submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the learned Court below for deciding the aforesaid application on the date fixed before it.
