Instant petition had been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the lives and personal liberty of the petitioners.

It has been noticed that Aadhaar Card of petitioner No.1 is apparently a forged document in which date of birth has been interpolated so as to verify the pleadings in the instant petition to the effect that petitioner No.1 has attained majority.

The aforesaid fact is controverted by the learned State counsel, who has pointed out that date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 24.08.2006. It has further been pointed out by the learned State counsel that the minor is now in the custody of her parents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw the instant petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
