Petitioner have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 453 dated 31.12.2020, under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC and Section 24 of Immigration Act, registered at Police Station Division No.8, Ludhiana and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 15.03.2021, parties were directed to appear before concerned Illaqa Magistrate/Trial Court for getting their statements recorded and the trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of the compromise.

A report dated 20.07.2021 of learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Ludhiana has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Ludhiana. Learned Magistrate has stated that the compromise is genuine and not

result of any pressure or coercion.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed.
FIR No. 453 dated 31.12.2020, under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC
and Section 24 of Immigration Act, registered at Police Station
Division No.8, Ludhiana, along with all subsequent proceedings
arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
