[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

[2] Prayer in the petition under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is for punishing the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 24.09.2020, in Cr.W.P. No.7459 of 2020.

[3] Learned Counsel contends that vide order, Annexure P/1 dated 24.09.2020, Cr.W.P. No.7459 of 2020 was disposed of by directing the respondent to look into the matter and decide the undated representation submitted by the petitioner and that the instant petition was filed on account of failure of the respondent to do the needful.

[4] Although, notice has not been issued in the instant petition, learned State counsel has filed compliance report dated 08.09.2021. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the

representation submitted by the petitioner having been decided by the respondent in terms of order, Annexure P/1 dated 24.09.2020 in Cr.W.P. No.7459 of 2020, the petitioner is satisfied with the action taken by the respondent and is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and the same may be disposed of accordingly.

[5] In view of the undated representation submitted by the petitioner having been decided on 08.09.2021 by the respondent in terms of order, Annexure P/1 dated 24.09.2020 in Cr.W.P. No.7459 of 2020 as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondent.

[6] Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as such.
