ANOOP CHITKARA J.

Short reply dated 24.03.2022 on behalf of the complainant has been filed and the same is taken on record.

Vide order dated 08.03.2022, this Court had granted interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 08.03.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. This fact is not refuted by learned counsel appearing for the State.
4. Learned counsel appearing for the complainant has strenuously opposed the bail.
5. Given the nature of allegations, no pre-trial incarceration is required. Without commenting on the case's merits and the circumstances peculiar to this case, the petitioner makes a case for release on bail.

6. Given above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 08.03.2022, is hereby made absolute subject to strict compliance of condition Nos.18 and 19 within a period of 10 days, if not already done. In case, it not comply with, on this ground alone, the bail may be cancelled.
