Prayer in this writ petition is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 5, not to summon the petitioner without following the proper procedure.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is a widow lady, living with her mother-in-law and the respondent No.5 – National Investigating Agency, has registered R.C. No.01/2021/NIA/DLI dated 26.01.2021 under Sections 302 and 34 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act and under Sections 16, 17, 18, 18-A, 18-B, 19, 20, 23 and 38 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, against the son of the petitioner namely Gurwinder Singh @ Baba and others. It is further submitted that the son of the petitioner namely Gurwinder Singh @ Baba is declared as a proclaimed offender and the respondent No.5 as well as the police are raiding the house of the

petitioner.

Counsel for the State appearing for the State of Punjab as well as learned Senior counsel appearing for respondent No.5, have however, submitted that the petitioner is not an accused in the aforesaid case/FIR and rather the police as well as NIA are visiting the house of the petitioner on earlier occasion for the purpose of arresting her son i.e. Gurwinder Singh @ Baba *qua* whom non-bailable warrants have been issued and for the purpose of executing the non-bailable warrants at the given address and now, the son of the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender.

It is stated at bar that the police is following a proper procedure and no harassment is being caused to the petitioner.

In view of the above, no further action is called for.
