The petitioner has prayed for the issuance of direction to the respondent No.2 to protect his life and liberty as he feels reasonable apprehension and threat perception at the hands of the respondent Nos.4 to 7.

Precisely, in the context of the aforesaid relief, the petitioner has approached the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar by way of complaint/representation dated 17.02.2022 (Annexure P-3) sent on 23.02.2022.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rehat Bir Singh Mann, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State.

At this stage, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, it would be just and appropriate to direct the concerned authority

to look into the grievance of the petitioner and pass an appropriate order on merits in accordance with law. The concerned authority would pass necessary order without being influenced by any pleadings made in the petition.

This order shall not debar the official respondents from proceeding against the petitioner, if he is involved in any other case. It would be appreciated if the needful is done within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
