The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.55 dated 21.06.2014, registered at Police Station Kot Dharmu, District Mansa, under Sections 279, 337 and 427 IPC, and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, including the order dated 09.03.2019 (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the above-noted FIR was registered way back in 2014; that with the approval of the competent authority, an untraced report was presented; that however vide order dated 09.03.2019, the Presiding Officer, National Lok Adalat, Mansa, had not accepted the untraced report and directed the concerned SHO for re-investigation.

In pursuance of notice of motion, reply by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Mansa, District Mansa

has already been filed.

A perusal of the report would show that after re-investigation conducted by the police, no clue had been found against the real culprit and that the untraced report was again prepared on 02.11.2021 and sent to the office of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa, for further orders.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition be disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail the appropriate remedy before the concerned Court, if necessity arises.

Disposed of the afore-mentioned terms.
