The hearing of the case is being held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This is petitioner's third attempt to get bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No. 25 dated 17.02.2019 registered under Section 398, 401, IPC and Sector 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Pillukhera, District Jind.

Previously, the petitioner has failed in two attempts. The allegations against the petitioner are that he alongwith the co-accused blocked the passage of a vehicle and forced it to stop with an intention to commit dacoity. From the petitioner, a country made pistol with live catridges has already been recovered. Learned counsel representing the petitioner admits that the petitioner is facing prosecution in as many as four criminal cases including one involving an offence under Section 302 IPC.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no fresh ground for the grant of concession of bail is made out.

Hence, dismissed.
