Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the petition is for quashing the FIR No.110 dated 14.06.2014, registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, at Police Station Basti Bawa Khel, District Jalandhar City and order dated 13.11.2018 passed by learned JMIC, Jalandhar (Annexure P-2) vide which petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3).

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present dispute is due to marital discord. He submits that now the parties have compromised the matter and settled their dispute amicably. He further submits that the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender on 13.11.2018. After arguing for some time, he prays for granting him liberty to approach the trial Court to avail his remedy as per law.

Finding the prayer made is genuine one, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the trial Court. In case the petitioner surrenders before the Court concerned within ten days from today and file an appropriate application then he would have a protection from his arrest for seven days from the date of filing of application. The trial Court is requested to decide the application expeditiously.
