Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case bearing FIR No.262 dated 21.12.2017 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Division 6, Ludhiana (Annexure P-1).

Vide order dated 07.03.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 07.03.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harcharan Singh Police Station Division 6, Ludhiana has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 07.03.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
