The prayer made by the petitioner in the instant writ petition is for issuance of necessary directions to officials respondents No. 2 to 4 to look into the grievance raised by the petitioner against respondent No.5 for committing a fraud, the details whereof were given by him in his representation dated 13.08.2021(Annexure P-1) made before the S.C. & S.T. Commission.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was cheated by respondent No.5 in collusion with other persons. Though, the matter was reported to the police, but no action has been taken by the police.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Hittan Nehra, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab who has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4 on service of advance copy of petition, has accepted the notice. He submits that no proof of making any representation has been placed on record by the petitioner. Still, the authority concerned will look into the grievance raised by the petitioner in case any representation is filed by him within two weeks from today.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to file a representation before respondent No.2 within two weeks, who shall look into the same and decide it in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.

Instant petition stands disposed of with abovesaid observations and directions.
