The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 145 dated 29.06.2021 registered under Sections 394, 397 and 285 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at City-Nuh, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that pursuant to the order dated 07.03.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for investigation of the case.

Learned State counsel on instruction from ASI Mani Ram corroborates the said averment and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required for the purpose of investigation.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 07.03.2022 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
