1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 28.05.2019, in CWP-14460-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1, dated 28.05.2019, reveals that CWP-14460-2019, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide legal notice dated 26.04.2019, served by the petitioner, in accordance with law, expeditiously, preferably within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. At the outset, learned DAG, Haryana, has produced order Annexure R/1 dated 10.06.2020, as per which, the claim of the petitioner union was considered and reference of the dispute between the parties has been made to the learned Industrial Tribunal, Faridabad. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof is stated to have been supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner. However, none is present on behalf of the petitioner.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as stand of learned DAG, Haryana in reply dated 03.02.2021 as also order Annexure R/1 dated 10.06.2020, referring the dispute between the parties for adjudication, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petition pending. Accordingly, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the contempt petition, if cause survives.
