Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.482 dated 1.10.2021 registered under Sections 20, 61, 85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Palla, District Faridabad.

Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance of order dated 8.3.2022 passed by this Court. This fact has not been refuted by the State counsel who on instructions from ASI Vijay submitted that the petitioner is not required for any investigation or custodial interrogation.

As per allegations appearing on the record, the petitioner was not named in the FIR and was arraigned as accused only on the basis of disclosure made by co-accused Sanjeet Kaur from whom 93 grams of smack was recovered. The aforesaid contraband comes under non-commercial quantity of contraband as per the provisions of NDPS Act. The alleged

recovery has already been effected in the present case and the petitioner is

not required by the police for any further investigation.

In view of the above and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 8.3.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
