The prayer in this petition is to quash the order dated 03.09.2021 (Annexure P-7) whereby the claim of the petitioner for the grant of pension has been declined after refusing to condone 10 days service so as to qualify the condition of 10 years service required for the grant of pensionary benefits.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State submits that though, the impugned order on the prayer of the petitioner was passed on 03.09.2021 but, the same needs reconsideration in view of the settled principle of law and therefore, the order dated 03.09.2021 (Annexure P-7) may kindly be treated as withdrawn with liberty to the respondents to pass afresh order.

Learned State counsel further submits that as, the prayer of the petitioner is for release of the pensionary benefits, the re-consideration of the

issue will be finalised in a time bound manner and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of four weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the fact that the impugned order has already been withdrawn with liberty to pass afresh order, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the present petition is disposed of as not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
