[1] Prayer in the petition under Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 17.12.2021 in CWP No.25222 of 2021.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.25222 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the respondent to treat the writ petition as representation of the petitioner and to decide the same keeping in view the submission made in paragraph No. 9 thereof in a time bound manner within 07 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Reply has been filed along with order (Annexure R-1) dated 21.03.2022, granting no objection certification for opening of College for Veterinary Livestock Development Diploma (VDD) by Smt. Sarti Devi Educational Charitable Trust (Regd.), Ateli Mandi, Mahendergarh. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof has already been supplied to
