As per the settlement/agreement dated 28.04.2022, a draft of Rs.5,00,000/- has been handed over to respondent-Neelam Jaiswal and petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act will be filed before 30.06.2022.

Learned counsel for the appellant states that as per the decision before the mediation at Serial No.3, the appellant will file a petition for quashing of FIR No.142 dated 16.06.2016, under Section 323/328/147/506/354A/149/498A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station, Sector-56, Gurugram, within a period of 30 days after the first motion statement.

Keeping in view the above statement, since the present appeal was filed against the interim maintenance order dated 18.12.2019, whereby interim maintenance of Rs.20,000/- was ordered to be paid from the date of

filing of the application i.e., 21.05.2018, no further orders are required to be passed in view of settlement/agreement dated 28.04.2022.

The appeal stands disposed of accordingly.
