Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to consider the case of petitioner and issue appointment letter for the post of Lecturer Electrical Engineering in pursuance of advertisement No.7 (P-1). Further prayer is for directing the respondents to keep one post vacant for petitioner during the pendency of present petition.

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the representation dated 09.12.2021 (P-5) is considered and decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent(s) and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without expressing any opinion about the claim of the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2-Secretary, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training, Punjab to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 09.12.2021 (P-5) in accordance with law by passing speaking order within four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
