This is the first petition for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.179 dated 14.11.2021, registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Central Sector-17, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for UT Chandigarh has pointed out that in the present case, the complainant has not been examined as yet.
