Earlier passport was issued to the petitioner and date of birth was recorded on the basis of matriculation certificate. He has applied for re-issuance of passport with corrected date of birth and for this purpose he is now relying upon the birth certificate.

In case direction is issued for correction of date of birth it will result in a discrepancy between the passport and the educational record. The petitioner is a student and wishes to travel abroad for further studies. The discrepancy will affect his prospects.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that an application has already been made for correction of the date of birth in his matriculation certificate.

Thus, the writ petition is permitted to be withdrawn with liberty to file a fresh one after necessary correction has been made in the matriculation certificate.
