AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

2. The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No 245, dated 28th August, 2021, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341, 435 and 506 Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 307 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Kalayat, District Kaithal.

3. As per the allegations of Salinder on 25th August, 2021, 20-25 persons gathered to kill his younger brother-Gurmej. Gurmej sustained injuries including gandas blow on the head. No specific injury was attributed to him but Binda (batten) was recovered from him. Petitioner is in custody since 25th September, 2021.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks bail on the ground that six co-accused were granted bail by the trial Court, no recovery is to be made from the petitioner and investigation is complete. Petitioner has no

criminal antecedents.

5. Learned State counsel opposes the prayer for grant of regular bail and submits that injury sustained by the injured declared as dangerous to life.

6. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering that no specific injury is attributed to the petitioner, the Gandasi blow was given by the co-accused, co-accused were granted bail, investigation is complete and conclusion of the trial is likely to take time, petitioner is granted bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.

7. The petition is allowed.

8. It is clarified that observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
