VINOD S. BHARDWAJ. J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed raising a challenge to the order dated 06.11.2019 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Kuruskshetra whereby the petitioner had been directed to make deposit of 20% of the compensation amount under Section 148 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

Pursuant to the notice of motion issued to respondent No.2, Mr. Ram Chander, Advocate appears and contends that the respondent no.2 undertakes not to press for deposit of the aforesaid 20% of the amount as directed vide order dated 06.11.2019 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra, so that the Criminal Appeal bearing No.63 of 2018 can be adjudicated upon. He further contends that he has no objection in case the said order is set aside with his consent.

In view of the statement so made on behalf of the contesting respondent for not seeking enforcement of the impugned order and a specific statement made at the Bar today that he has no objection to the order dated

06.11.2019 being set aside, the present revision petition is allowed and the order dated 0611.2019 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra is set aside. The lower Appellate Court is directed to proceed further in accordance with law to adjudicate upon the appeal expeditiously and preferably within 06 months from the date next fixed before the lower Appellate Court.

Petition is allowed.
