1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/2 dated 01.02.2022, in CRM-M-671-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/2 reveals that CRM-M-671-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to take a decision in accordance with law and pass a speaking order in respect of the representation filed by the petitioner, within three weeks.

3. Learned AAG, Punjab, has filed reply by way of affidavit of SI, Harpal Singh, SHO, Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar, along with speaking order Annexure R/1 dated 12.03.2022, consigning the application to the record room, as the allegations levelled in the representation bearing No.66 dated 10.02.2022, had not been substantiated. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same, states that in view of order Annexure R/1 dated 12.03.2022, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge the same by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
