These two petitions have been filed seeking regular bail in case of FIR No. 153 dated 19.7.2019, under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Samrala, District Khanna.

As per the case set up, commercial quantity of contrabands were recovered from the petitioners and co-accused. One of the ground pressed for seeking regular bail is the custody period and the fact that the trial is not proceedings at a decent pace.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that out of thirteen prosecution witnesses, four have been examined, the remaining witnesses are mostly the police officials. He submits that earnest effort would be made to conclude the prosecution evidence within four months.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seek permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

There is no doubt that in case a request is made before the trial Court for expeditious conclusion of the trial, the same would be considered in accordance with law.
