The present petition has been filed seeking writ in the nature of habeas corpus to release the persons, whose names have been depicted in paragraph-4 of the present petition as they are being detained illegally by respondents No.4 and 6 against their wishes at the brick kiln as bonded labours.

On being pointed out, as to whether, before filing the present petition, the petitioner has approached the authority concerned raising the said grievance, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not availed the remedy available with him and prays that the petitioner be allowed to withdraw the present petition, at this stage, with liberty to approach the Deputy Commissioner, District Sonapat, (Haryana) raising the said grievance by filing an appropriate representation.

Learned State counsel submits that in case, any representation is filed by the petitioner raising the said grievance with the concerned

authority, the same will be decided within a period of 04 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the same after holding due enquiry into the allegations and in case any action needs to be taken, the same will also be taken within the aforesaid period.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above, the present petition may be disposed of having been not pressed any further with the liberty as prayed for.
