SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is an accused in FIR No. 141 dated 16.10.2019 registered at Police Station Meharban, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, and, he claimed relief that the investigations, as underway into the above FIR, be transferred from the agency probing them, to some other agency, as he averred that the investigations, as underway therein, are skewed, and, slanted.

2. Even though, the above averments are not supported, by any tangible evidence, but as stated at the bar by learned State Counsel, on instructions given to him, by Head Constable Varidner Singh, that after completion of investigations to the FIR, a cancellation report, has been recommended to be instituted before the learned trial Magistrate concerned.

3. Therefore, the instant petition does not survive, and, rather becomes rendered infructuous.

4. Disposed of accordingly.
