Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.15 dated 14.02.2022 registered under Sections 457, 380 IPC at Police Station Hathur, District Ludhiana (Rural) and to decide the representation dated 02.03.2022.

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have given a representation on 02.03.2022 and the same be decided.

Surprisingly, the present petition is filed on the very next day i.e. on 03.03.2022, without giving any time to the authorities to conclude the investigation even in the main FIR.

Counsel for the State also raises an objection that this petition is pre-mature as the FIR has been registered recently just 15 days ago and the police is conducting proper investigation.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous, being pre-mature.
