1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P1 dated 15.07.2019, in CWP-22531-2010.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-22531-2010, was disposed of vide order dated 15.07.2019, by directing the respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner in the light of notification dated 10.06.2015, 04.11.2015 as well as judgment in CWP-12299-2017, in case titled as Pradeep Kumar vs. State of Haryana and others, within twelve weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and if on consideration the competent authority arrived at the conclusion that the claim of the petitioners was admissible, then in such eventuality, to allow consequential relief to the petitioners within six weeks thereafter.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that respondent No.2 has passed order Annexure R/1 dated 15.07.2020,

rejecting the claim of the petitioners and the petitioners have challenged said order by way of CWP-20451-2020, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioners may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to pursue their claim in the writ petition.

4. The aforementioned course of action is not opposed to by the learned State Counsel.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioners to pursue their claim, in CWP-20451-2020, in accordance with law.
