The present petition has been filed by the petitioner praying for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.23 dated 05.02.2021 registered under Sections 408, 420, 467, 471 IPC at Police Station Sector 65, District Gurugram

Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation in the light of previous order dated 08.03.2022 passed by this Court. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that earlier Akash Kumar son of the petitioner had made payment of Rs.22,00,000/- to the complainant-company and thereafter another 16,00,000/- was paid to the complainant-company on behalf of the accused persons and thus the entire disputed amount has been paid to the complainant-company by the petitioner and his son.

Status report by way of affidavit of ASI Suresh Kumar No.311/GGM, Investigating Officer, P.S. Sector-65, Gurugram has been filed on behalf of the State, the same is taken on record.

State counsel on instructions ASI Deepak Kumar has not refuted the

fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and further submits that now the petitioner is not required by the police for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, present petition is hereby allowed without commenting on the merits of the case and the order of interim bail dated 08.03.2022 is hereby made absolute. However the petitioner is to abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
