Present petition has been filed by the petition under Section 482 Cr. P.C. seeking direction to respondents No. 2 to 4 to take necessary action against the private respondents after conducting fair investigation, as they had entered in the house of petitioner and issued threats to kill the petitioner and also demolished boundary wall in violation of status quo order passed by lower Court on 19.02.2018.

Perusal of the file reveals that after issuance of notice of motion vide order dated 20.03.2018, matter came up for hearing on 10.07.2018, but on that day no one was present on behalf of the petitioner and matter was adjourned to 25.10.2018. Till date neither any application was moved by the petitioner nor matter was ever taken for its hearing.

Today also none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to agitate the issue raised in the petition.

On the other side, learned State counsel, on instructions submits that one hand written compromise note dated 30.06.2018 had also been

handed over to the Investigating Officer by the petitioner in the year 2018, itself.

In view of the aforementioned circumstances when none is appearing on behalf of petitioner side and also the fact as highlighted by learned State counsel that one hand written compromise note had already been given to the Investigating Officer in the year 2018 itself, nothing appears to survive in the present matter, therefore, present petition is ordered to be dismissed for non- prosecution.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
