The petitioners have come up in this civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner being widow regarding family pension and other retiral benefits alongwith the claim of giving compassionate appointment to the petitioners No.2 or 3, for which, legal notice dated 29.09.2020 (Annexure P-4) has also been served upon the respondent-authorities.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioners, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the legal notice dated 20.09.2020 (Annexure P-4) of

the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

If the petitioners are held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to them without any delay.
