This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.96 dated 14.06.2009 registered under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

It has been pointed out to the learned counsel for the petitioner that earlier three co-accused had approached this Court for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise dated 24.06.2009 and initially, their case was allowed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court but however on a subsequent application moved by the complainant to the effect that the compromise has not been effected, the order quashing the FIR on the basis of compromise

was recalled and the main petition itself was dismissed. Thus, the compromise dated 24.06.2009 cannot possibly be taken into consideration for the purpose of quashing of the present FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the matter has been compromised between the present petitioner and respondent No.2 and thus, he be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh petition by placing on record fresh compromise deed and also by making additional prayers.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
