Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.93 dated 31.07.2018, registered for offences under Sections 376 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 3 and 4 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, at Police Station Phool, District Bathinda, Annexure P-1.

Vide order dated 26.04.2022, this Court directed the petitioner to appear before the Trial court/Area Magistrate within a period of ten days and on his doing so, it was directed that he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail/personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Court concerned.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has appeared before the Trial Court and has been released on ad-interim bail.

This fact has been confirmed by the State counsel upon instructions received from ASI, Jaswinder Singh. State counsel further submits that charge has been framed against the petitioner.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the allegations levelled in the FIR, order dated 26.04.2022 is made absolute.

Petition is allowed.
