MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.28 dated 29.01.2022 under Sections 323, 34 and 506 Indian Penal Code, 1860 [Section 3(1) (S) Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 added later on] registered at Police Station City Badhra, District Charkhi Dadri, Haryana who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 08.03.2022, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order dated 21.02.2022 (Annexure P-3) passed by this Court in CRM-M-6904-2022 and contends that the case of the petitioner is at par with co-accused Kuldeep @ Kuldeep Sharma, who is on interim pre arrest bail.

Notice of motion for 07.04.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M-6904-2022.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated himself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by DSP Deshraj states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 08.03.2022 is made absolute.
