Prayer in this 2nd petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.157 dated 28.09.2020 registered under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 34 IPC (Section 308 IPC added subsequently) at Police Station Rangar Nangal, District Batala.

The earlier one was dismissed as withdrawn on 23.09.2021 with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 01 week and the trial Court was directed to dispose of the regular bail application of the petitioner, within a period of 02 days thereafter.

After about 05 months, the present petition has been filed, without any change of circumstances except that all the other co-accused are on bail.

As per the allegations in the FIR, registered on the statement of Jagpreet Singh, it is stated that when he was returning to his house on the date of incident, the petitioner Sukhdev Singh along

with other co-accused namely Vikramjit Singh and Kiranjit Kaur, wife of the petitioner, caused injuries to the victim. The petitioner has given a datar blow, which hit on the forehead of the victim and his son gave an iron rod blow, which hit on his right arm. When his father Kulwinder Singh came at the spot, the petitioner also gave him a datar blow, which hit on his forehead.

Considering the serious allegations against the petitioner, I find no ground to grant the concession of the anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.

The Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, is directed to furnish an explanation as to why despite dismissal of the first bail application and a lapse of about 05 months, the petitioner is not arrested in the case.
