1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 01.12.2021, in CWP-24300-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-24300-2021, was disposed of vide order dated 01.12.2021, by directing the respondent to consider and decide representation filed by the petitioner, in accordance with law, preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case on decision it was found that the petitioner was entitled to the amount in question, the same be paid to the petitioner within one month thereafter, failing which, the petitioner would be entitled to interest on the amount @ 6% per annum w.e.f. date of entitlement till realization of the amount.

3. Notice has not yet been issued in this case.

4. Reply has been filed by the learned State counsel. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the

petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

6. Rule discharged.
