[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 13.07.2020, in CWP No.9585 of 2020 in case titled as '**Rajeev Kawatra** versus **State of Haryana and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.9585 of 2020, was disposed of vide order dated 13.07.2020 with a direction to the respondent to examine the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of representation dated 16.06.2020 and to take a final decision in respect thereto expeditiously and in any case within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that needful having been done by the respondent by passing order dated 26.04.2021, accepting the claim of the petitioner, as contained in representation dated 16.06.2020 and the financial benefits in respect thereto having been released to the petitioner, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
