Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail on account of absence of the petitioner from the first appellate Court during the pendency of the criminal appeal CRA No.505 of 2018 titled Ranvir Singh v. Ranjit Kaur and consequent thereof, non-bailable warrants of the petitioner were issued.

The appeal is relating to conviction of the petitioner under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act with regard to dishonour of cheque worth ₹ 45,000/-. Offence is bailable.

In view of above, without adverting into the merits of the case, present petition is hereby disposed of with direction that the petitioner should appear before the first appellate Court on or before the next date of hearing and on his appearance, he is directed to be released on regular bail by the said Court to its own satisfaction. Said Court is also at liberty to proceed against the petitioner under Section 446 Cr.P.C.
