The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for direction to respondent No. 2 to get the investigation conducted in FIR No. 207 dated 14.11.2016 under Sections 302 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, impartially and properly.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, cancellation report has been filed in the Court of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Tarn Taran on 13.05.2022 and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he is not in touch with the petitioner and thus, cannot rebut the abovesaid fact.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, morso, the fact that the cancellation report has been submitted before the

trial Court as stated by learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

However, it would be open to the petitioner to take all the pleas as raised in the present petition during the course of the proceedings before the trial court.
